Besides a four-course haute cuisine prepared by chef Franck Mischler, the chef du cuisine of Auberge du Cheval Blanc, a two-star Michelin restaurant in Paris, and chef Alfred Holzfiend, the chef du cuisine of Grand Hotel Panhans in Austria, diners will also be treated to an eye-popping show put together by artistes from all over the world. The Mirror Tent is a huge marquee spanning the Padang and incorporates 1,500 mirrors – more than enough for everyone to check if they've got anything stuck in their teeth. Also look out for a new variant beer, Salson Sayang, brewed especially by Archipelago for The Crystal Mirror. We'll drink to that!
