



MIRROR EFFECT

A piece of bohemia has arrived in Singapore in the form of The Crystal Mirror, a spectacular dinner theatre set in a tent embellished with 1,500 mirrors. Inspired by popular entertainment of 19th century Europe, mirror tents were set up to house music and theatre festivals. And revived for the first time in Asia, The Crystal Mirror is a multi-sensory feast coupled with a three and a half hour stage show. This ambitious production sees two award-winning chefs from Austria and France dishing out a four-course haute cuisine menu, while acrobatics and theatrical artistry are staged simultaneously. Expect to dine on classic European fare with Viennese and Parisian influences such as glazed French quail with foie gras stuffing accompanied by spinach flan and tomato confit, seared lupe de mer on Alsace Riseling-seafood risotto, and Austrian curd dumpling filled with marzipan and nougat, which are prepared by acclaimed Michelin-starred chefs Franck Mischler and Alfred Holzfiend.
